

Attractions near CUA campus: Additional Information

2 – Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception

- Immediately adjacent to CUA
- Lower level: gift shop, bookstore, cafeteria, chapels, Crypt Church, confessionals, information desk (including guided tours)
- Upper level: main church with side chapels
- **Masses:** Sunday (upper church) – 5:15 Sat vigil, 7:30, 9, 10:30 a.m., 12 noon, 1:30 (Spa), 4:30 p.m.
Daily (Crypt church): 7, 7:30, 8, 8:30 a.m., 12:10, 5:15 p.m.
- **Confession** (next to Crypt church): Sunday – 10-12 noon, 12:30-1:30 p.m. (Spa), 2-4 p.m.
Daily: 7:45-8:15 a.m., 10 a.m.-12 noon, 3:30-6 p.m.
- **Adoration** (Crypt church): Mon-Thurs 9 a.m.-12 noon, Friday 1-5 p.m.

3 – Saint John Paul II National Shrine

- Across the street from CUA at 3900 Harewood Road NE
- Lower level: gift shop, museum exhibit about St. John Paul II
- Main level: Redemptor Hominis church, reliquary chapel (with first class relic of St. John Paul II), information desk
- **Masses:** Sunday 11 a.m. and 2 p.m., daily 12 noon
- **Divine Mercy Devotion:** Daily 3 p.m.

Note: on the weekends, a shuttle runs every 20 minutes from the Basilica to the John Paul II Shrine.

8 – St. Anthony of Padua Catholic parish

- 1029 Monroe Street NE
- **Masses:** Sunday 7, 10 a.m., 12 noon, 6 p.m.; daily 8 a.m.
- **Confessions:** Tuesday after 6:30 p.m. Mass

9 – Franciscan Monastery of the Holy Land in America

- About a mile away from CUA at 1400 Quincy Street NE
- Outside: Rosary walk, replicas of Holy Land sites, replica of the Portincula (St. Francis), flower gardens
- Inside: gift shop, main church, replicas of Holy Land sites, and guided tour
- [Brookland Arts Walk](#), between the metro station and Monroe Street NE; a pedestrian-only walk with galleries and studios; check ahead for store hours
- **Masses:** Sunday 5 p.m. Sat vigil, 8, 10 a.m., 12 noon, 2 p.m. (Spa)
Daily: Mon-Sat except Tues 7 a.m., Tues 9 a.m., 5:30 p.m.
- **Confession:** Mon-Sat 9, 10, 11 a.m., 1, 2, 3, 4 p.m.
