

Adolescents that ready Puberty are now biological Capable of Reproducing.


But, we must ask (and so should they!):

BRAIN DEVELOPMENT - FRONTAL LOBE






- Center of Rational Thought & Decision Making
- Not Fully Mature Until Mid 20's



BRAIN DEVELOPMENT – LIMBIC SYSTEM

- Mediates Impulsive Behavior
- Dominates During Childhood and Adolescence



DEVELOPING TEENS (ERIKSON)



- Believe to be Invulnerable
- Are developing a Personal Identity
- Are discerning Vocational Goals & Ethical Stance
- Live in the Present Moment
- Their thinking is concrete...
- Their abstract thinking is not quite there yet...
- Talking about Consequences is relatively Meaningless

SOME STATS...



5% of boys and 1% of girls initiated intercourse before age 12 years.

Approximately 30% of boys and 20% of girls had experienced sexual intercourse at least once by age 14 years.

Among the teens who become sexually active, 68% reported oral sex and 85% reported vaginal intercourse. (American Academy of Pediatrics - Jan 1, 2013)

By the age 18, 55% of both males and females have had sex. (CDC – 2017)



THE TRAGIC DISCONNECT...



If during adolescence decisions are <u>ruled by the</u> <u>limbic system</u>, then why does our culture invite teens to begin sexual relations "when they <u>feel</u> ready (but do not have the full capacity to think about consequences yet?"

This can only lead to disastrous *physical* and *emotional* results.

AS ADOLESCENTS MATURE



WHAT'S DIFFERENT ABOUT TEEN STAR'S APPROACH?





Adolescents spend a great amount of mental energy focusing on the physical and hormonal components of their emerging sexuality.

Teen STAR engages this energy and accompanies them in the process of understanding their fertility.

Girls learn to chart their fertile signs and boys learn to chart their emotions.

FOR TEENS, UNDERSTANDING THEIR BODY IS KEY TO



Integrating these signs of fertility into their

- Emotions
- Relationships
- Long-Term Goals

involves thinking and a spirituality that lead to mature behavioral outcomes.

Still... Teen STAR is much more than this...

TEEN STAR - PEDAGOGY



- Teen STAR is oriented to the level of psychological & sexual maturity of the participant (Middle School, High School, Young Adult)
- For girls, the self-discovery of fertility biomarkers (they chart their cycles) is key to internalizing and understanding fertility and sexuality.
- Boys learn to understand and master their body's reactions and emotions, as well as their fertility and sexuality.
- **×** Both learn the implications of possessing these powers.
- Lesson plans promote the use of the Socrative Method as well as interactive skits and activities that engage the students.
- Through Follow-ups and Exit Questionnaires, TS monitors behavioral outcomes.

TEEN STAR - PEDAGOGY



- Begins with what is GIVEN
- Never abandons the PHYSICAL (Biomarkers)
- Respects TIMING and NATURAL processes
- Integrates AFFECT and REASON
- **×** Always **ACCOMPANIES** the young person.

INTRODUCTORY SEQUENCE FOR COURSE



- First parent meeting (Parental consent is Mandatory!)
- × Invitation to students.
- × Consent from student, then parent or guardian.
- Class meets weekly or biweekly.
- Gender separated for anatomy and physiology, co-ed for social and spiritual components (second semester).
 - + Some schools or groups might keep the classes separate for the entire program.


COURSE SEQUENCE (CONT')



- Individual follow-up meetings with each student at least once per semester (<u>preferably</u> twice each semester)
- × Preferably, women teach girls, men teach boys
- Three Parent Meetings
 - + Initial Meeting before starting
 - + Second parent meeting after three months
 - + Last parent meeting at end of course, with evaluation

WHAT DOES TEEN STAR RESULT IN?





The revolution against the **historical forms** of sexuality ends in a revolution against **biology**.



IMPLICATIONS FOR TODAY'S CULTURE WARS

- Acceptance of their (now) present fertility and sexuality moves teens from peer pressure to making their own (responsible) decisions. This undergirds not only chastity but their biological sexual identity.
- Teen STAR is more than a sexuality education program, it helps adolescents and young adults to discover who they are and accept the truth of their bodies and their souls.

INSTRUCTOR TRAINING



- Instructor Training Offered at different locations at least twice a year (and on demand)
- ★ 3-4 day Seminars.
 - + Instructors receive:
 - Copies of Manuals
 - × Flash Drive with Resources for their classes
 - × Intensive training that aids them in planning Lessons and Accompanying the students.
 - × Access to Webinars from Teen STAR Office
 - Support from Teen STAR Supervisors and Office
- Additional ancillary materials and resources available to purchase through our Teen STAR Office.



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


Total Pregnancy Rate for one year Control Group & Teen STAR Program Group








Programa Teen STAR 1,01 %



Effects of teenstar, an abstinence only sexual education program, on adolescent sexual behavior

Background: Urgent measures are required to stop the increase in the frequency of pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases among teenagers. A means of facing this problem is promoting sexual abstinence among youngsters. There are studies that confirm the efficacy of this approach. Aim: To show the results of the application of a holistic sexuality program (TeenSTAR) among Chilean teenagers. Subjects and Methods: Students attending basic or high school were divided into a control or study group. The control group (342 students) received the usual education on sexuality given by their schools and the study group (398 students) participated in twelve TeenSTAR sessions lasting 1.5 hours each, given by a trained professor. Assessment of achievements was made using an anonymous questionnaire answered at the start and end of the program. Results: The rates of sexual initiation among control and study groups were 15 and 6.5%, respectively. Among sexually active students, 20% of those in the study group and 9% of those in the control group discontinued sexual activity. Conclusions: A higher proportion of students in the TeenSTAR program retarded their sexual initiation or discontinued sexual activity and found more reasons to maintain sexual abstinence than control students (Rev Méd Chile 2005; 133: 1173-82).


