- Donor is an organizational member and would like to remain anonymous. Donor will not be involved in the execution of the website development
- Rebranding questions Who is our organization established for just professional members or are families included as were initially intended.
- Question about are we open to a name change which will provide a new face for the organization and get back to the roots of NACFLM which originally incorporated families.
 - Conversation revolved around:
 - should this be brought before the region by the region reps so as not to have people surprised by sudden and big changes; Feedback from members will be weighed as one of several options
 - How do we rebrand in a time sensitive way and make us relevant to those who are members.
 - What audiences are being served professionals and/or families, how are we serving them?
 - keep on a timeline, not drag on too long, move forward.
 - We cannot come up with a brand or clarity or website until we have clarity as to who we are. Conference is best way to communicate to membership.

Federation Update – Jake

Grant Update – Jason

- About a dozen grants were submitted and a new deadline is coming up in March.
