



Grades 4-8: Submit a poem (up to 30 lines), an essay of 150-500 words, either clearly handwritten or typed (double-spaced, 12 point font, and 1 inch margins). Submit art or music or video. On the back of the page, print your name, age, school - including city, phone number, as well as the name of your teacher. Submit official Kalamazoo Diocese cover letter (one per entry).

Grades 9-12: Submit a poem (up to 30 lines), an essay of 250-500 words, typed, double-spaced, 12 point font and 1 inch margins. Submit art or music or video (as per the oriteria). On the back of the page, print your name, age, school including city, phone number, as well as the name of your teacher. Submit official Kalamazoo Diocese cover letter (one per entry).

Criteria for submissions Grades 4-8

Grades 4–8: Submit a poem (up to 30 lines), an essay of 150–500 words, either clearly handwritten or typed (double-spaced, 12 point font, and 1 inch margins). Submit art or music or video. On the back of the page, print your name, age, school – including city, phone number, as well as the name of your teacher. Submit official Kalamazoo Diocese cover letter (one per entry).



Criteria for submissions Grades 9-12

Grades 9–12: Submit a poem (up to 30) lines), an essay of 250–500 words, typed, double-spaced, 12 point font and 1 inch margins. Submit art or music or video (as per the criteria). On the back of the page, print your name, age, school including city, phone number, as well as the name of your teacher. Submit official Kalamazoo Diocese cover letter (one per entry).



Criteria and cover sheet for all entries

Art, Writing, Music & Video Student Contest Criteria "The Family Fully Alive"¹ How is my family fully alive in the faith? Take time to celebrate your family!

Prose/Poetry

Must be submitted with OFFICIAL cover sheet Must be typed or word processed. Each entry cannot include reference to student or school name. Prose must be 150 words to no more than 500 words in length. Word count must be noted on cover sheet. Poem must be no more than 30 lines. Line count must be included at end. Must reflect genuine reflection on the theme, The Family Fully Alive, and constitute a thoughtful and creative response.

<u>Art</u>

Must be submitted with OFFICIAL cover sheet Must not be matted or framed. May only be two-dimensional and must not exceed 12" by 18". Must include fixatives so that works will not smudge or be altered by handling Must include the artist's *title of the work* May include photography, computer generated images, or may be in charcoal, pencil, watercolors, acrylics or oils. Please note all images whether computer, artist or photo generated, are considered property of the original artist. Renderings of other works will be disqualified.

Music/Songwriting/Video

Must be submitted as MP3 or DVD with OFFICIAL cover sheet Must submit original music score for music Must submit original music score and lyrics for song

All entries become the property of the Diocese of Kalamazoo. All artists are encouraged to retain a color copy of their work since the original may not be returned. The Diocese of Kalamazoo shall own all the rights to all the entries, including copyrights and may publish the entries, in whole, or in part.
